* Goals. The primary goal of the seventh workshop in the CHARM series is to discuss contemporary and future aspects of charm physics. Topics to be covered at this conference include spectroscopy, heavy flavors in media, production and decays of charmed mesons and baryons, physics of charmonium states, D-mixing and CP-violation, advances in theoretical tools, future experimental facilities, and other related topics. Since this year's workshop is held at Wayne State, we plan to reserve more time than usual for heavy quark physics in heavy ion collisions.

The program will consist of plenary and parallel talks covering recent theoretical and experimental advances in the field.
